

Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how **Saunística / M.Proyecto** (“Saunística”, “we”, “us” or “our”) uses cookies and similar technologies on www.saunistica.com.

This policy should be read together with our **Privacy Policy**, which explains how we process and protect personal data.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your device when you visit a website.

Cookies can be used for different purposes, such as enabling essential website functions, remembering preferences, understanding how visitors use a website or providing content from third-party services.

Some cookies are placed directly by Saunística (“first-party cookies”), while others may be placed by external service providers (“third-party cookies”).

Cookies may also be:

- **Session cookies**, which are deleted when you close your browser.
- **Persistent cookies**, which remain on your device for a defined period or until you delete them.

2. How We Use Cookies

We may use cookies and similar technologies for the following purposes:

- To ensure that the website functions correctly.
- To maintain website security.
- To remember your cookie preferences.
- To remember certain website or language preferences.
- To understand how visitors use our website.
- To measure website performance and improve our content.
- To display embedded content such as videos or maps.
- To enable certain third-party services and integrations.

Cookies that are not strictly necessary for the operation of the website will not be activated before you have given your consent where consent is required by applicable law.

3. Types of Cookies We Use

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are required for the website to function correctly and cannot normally be disabled through our cookie consent system.

They may be used, for example, to:

- Maintain website security.
- Remember your cookie consent choices.
- Enable basic website functionality.
- Support forms and other essential website features.

Because these cookies are necessary to provide the website and its essential functions, they do not normally require your consent.

You may be able to block these cookies through your browser settings, but some parts of the website may then stop functioning correctly.

Preference and Functionality Cookies

These cookies allow the website to remember choices you make, such as language, region or other preferences.

Where these cookies are strictly necessary to provide a functionality specifically requested by you, consent may not be required. In other situations, they will only be activated with your consent.

Analytics Cookies

Analytics cookies help us understand how visitors interact with our website.

They may provide information such as:

- Which pages are visited.
- How visitors arrive at the website.
- How long visitors remain on particular pages.
- Which website features are used.
- General information about devices and browsers.
- Technical errors or performance issues.

Where analytics cookies or similar technologies require consent, they will only be activated after you have accepted them through our cookie consent system.

We use analytics information to understand website performance and improve our website, products, services and content.

Marketing and Advertising Cookies

If used, marketing cookies may be used to understand visitor interests, measure advertising performance or show more relevant advertising on other websites or platforms.

These cookies may allow third-party advertising or social media providers to create information about your browsing activity.

Marketing and advertising cookies will only be activated where permitted and after you have given the required consent.

Third-Party and Embedded Content Cookies

Our website may contain content or functionality provided by third parties, such as:

- YouTube or other video services.
- Google Maps or other map services.
- Social media platforms.
- External forms or communication services.
- Other embedded third-party content.

When such content is activated, the third-party provider may place cookies or use similar technologies on your device.

Where consent is required, third-party content that uses non-essential cookies will not be activated until you have provided the appropriate consent.

Third-party providers process information according to their own privacy and cookie policies, and Saunística does not control the cookies placed directly by those third parties.

4. Cookies Currently Used on This Website

The exact cookies and similar technologies used on www.saunistica.com may change as the website, its functionality and external services are updated.

Our cookie consent tool provides current information about the cookies detected or used on this website, including where available:

- Cookie name.
- Provider.
- Purpose.
- Cookie category.

- Expiration or retention period.

You can view this information and change your preferences at any time by opening **Cookie Settings** on our website.

5. Google Services

Our website may use services provided by **Google LLC** or other companies within the Google group.

Depending on the services enabled on the website, these may include services such as:

Google Maps

Google Maps may be used to display our showroom, pickup warehouse or business location.

When you activate or interact with an embedded Google Map, Google may collect information about your device, IP address and interaction with the map and may place cookies or use similar technologies.

Where required, Google Maps will only be loaded after you have provided the appropriate consent.

YouTube

Our website may contain videos embedded from YouTube.

YouTube may collect information about your interaction with embedded videos and may use cookies or similar technologies.

Where required, embedded YouTube content that uses non-essential cookies will only be activated after you have provided the appropriate consent.

Google Analytics

If Google Analytics is enabled on our website, it may be used to collect statistical information about how visitors use the website.

Where consent is required, Google Analytics will not be activated until you have accepted analytics cookies.

The specific Google services currently active on the website are reflected in our cookie consent settings.

6. WordPress and Website Functionality

Our website is built using **WordPress** and may use WordPress plugins and related technologies to provide website functionality.

WordPress or installed plugins may use cookies for purposes such as:

- Website functionality.
- Security.
- Forms.
- Language preferences.
- Cookie consent management.
- Website administration.

Cookies used solely for website administration and not placed on ordinary visitors are not necessarily relevant to every website visitor.

Any non-essential cookies generated by WordPress plugins or connected services are subject to the same consent requirements described in this Cookie Policy.

7. Your Cookie Choices

When you first visit our website, you may be presented with a cookie banner or consent panel.

Depending on the cookies used, you will have the possibility to:

- **Accept** non-essential cookies.
- **Reject** non-essential cookies.
- **Manage or customise** your cookie preferences.

Rejecting non-essential cookies must not be more difficult than accepting them.

Strictly necessary cookies may remain active because they are required for the website to function.

Your decision not to accept analytics, marketing or other optional cookies will not prevent you from using the essential functions of our website.

8. Changing or Withdrawing Your Consent

You can change your cookie preferences or withdraw your consent at any time.

You can do this through the **Cookie Settings** option available on our website.

Withdrawing consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out before consent was withdrawn.

After changing your preferences, certain previously stored cookies may remain on your device until they expire or are deleted through your browser settings. Where technically possible, our consent management system will prevent further use of cookies for purposes you have rejected.

9. Managing Cookies Through Your Browser

Most web browsers allow you to control cookies through their settings.

Depending on your browser, you may be able to:

- View stored cookies.
- Delete individual cookies.
- Delete all cookies.
- Block cookies.
- Block third-party cookies.
- Prevent websites from storing cookies.
- Configure different settings for different websites.

Please note that blocking all cookies may affect the functionality of this and other websites.

Instructions for managing cookies are available in the help or privacy settings of your browser.

10. Legal Basis for the Use of Cookies

Strictly necessary cookies are used where they are required to provide the website or functionality requested by the user.

For cookies that are not strictly necessary, such as certain analytics, advertising, tracking or third-party cookies, we rely on your **consent** where required under applicable law.

Consent must be freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous.

We do not treat inactivity, continued browsing or pre-selected options as consent to non-essential cookies.

11. How Long Cookies Are Stored

The storage period depends on the individual cookie.

Some cookies are automatically deleted when you close your browser, while others may remain on your device for a longer period.

Information about the duration of individual cookies is available through our **Cookie Settings** panel where applicable.

We periodically review the cookies and similar technologies used on our website and aim to limit their duration to what is reasonably necessary for their intended purpose.

12. Third-Party Processing and International Data Transfers

Some third-party services used on our website may process information outside Spain or outside the European Economic Area (EEA).

Where personal data is transferred internationally, the relevant provider must use an appropriate legal mechanism where required under applicable data protection legislation.

These mechanisms may include:

- A European Commission adequacy decision.
- Standard Contractual Clauses approved by the European Commission.
- Other recognised legal safeguards.
